| Saskatchewan | NO | Eligible worker will receive \$400 per month for up to 16 weeks (March 15 through July 4) | Government of SK - link |

| Ontario | NO | All eligible workers to receive \$4 per hour worked on top of existing hourly wages. Those who work at least 100 hours in a designated 4-week period will also be eligible for an additional lump sum payment of \$250 for that period. | Government of ON - link |
| Quebec | YES | The program provides \$100 for each week of qualifying work beginning March 15, 2020, and extending for a maximum of 16 weeks. | Revenu Quebec - link |

| Prince Edward Island | YES | Eligible employees earning \$3,000 per month or less will receive a one-time payment of \$1,000, administered through their employer. | Government of PEI - link |
